GENERAL INFORMATION

In response to the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) ICC Sydney has put in place all steps and precautions throughout the venue as recommended by the Australian Government Department for Health, to help ensure the safety of our visitors and team members. This includes:

- Placing hand sanitisers with supporting signage
- Placing guidance on hand washing in bathrooms
- Placing tissues and bins for their hygienic disposal with supporting signage on Coughing Etiquette
- Thorough and regular sterilisation of surfaces, including bathrooms, benches, ATM machines and all touch points such as door handles, escalator rails, etc.
- Continued rigorous adherence to ISO and HACCP food safety management standards within all culinary services

In line with official guidance for the general population, we are not recommending the use of face masks or thermal scanners at ICC Sydney.
